

Gratitude Tree ~ Directions

Material Prep: Print the color tree and leaves on card stock quality paper, if available and cut out. If you wish to use these over and over again, laminate and use a dry erase marker to write on the leaves.

Print the black and white tree and leaves on regular paper. Cut out leaves.

Directions: Discuss the definition of gratitude with your students. If you are giving each child their own individual tree, I recommend giving them 6-8 leaves, but this really depends on your students developmental level and age.

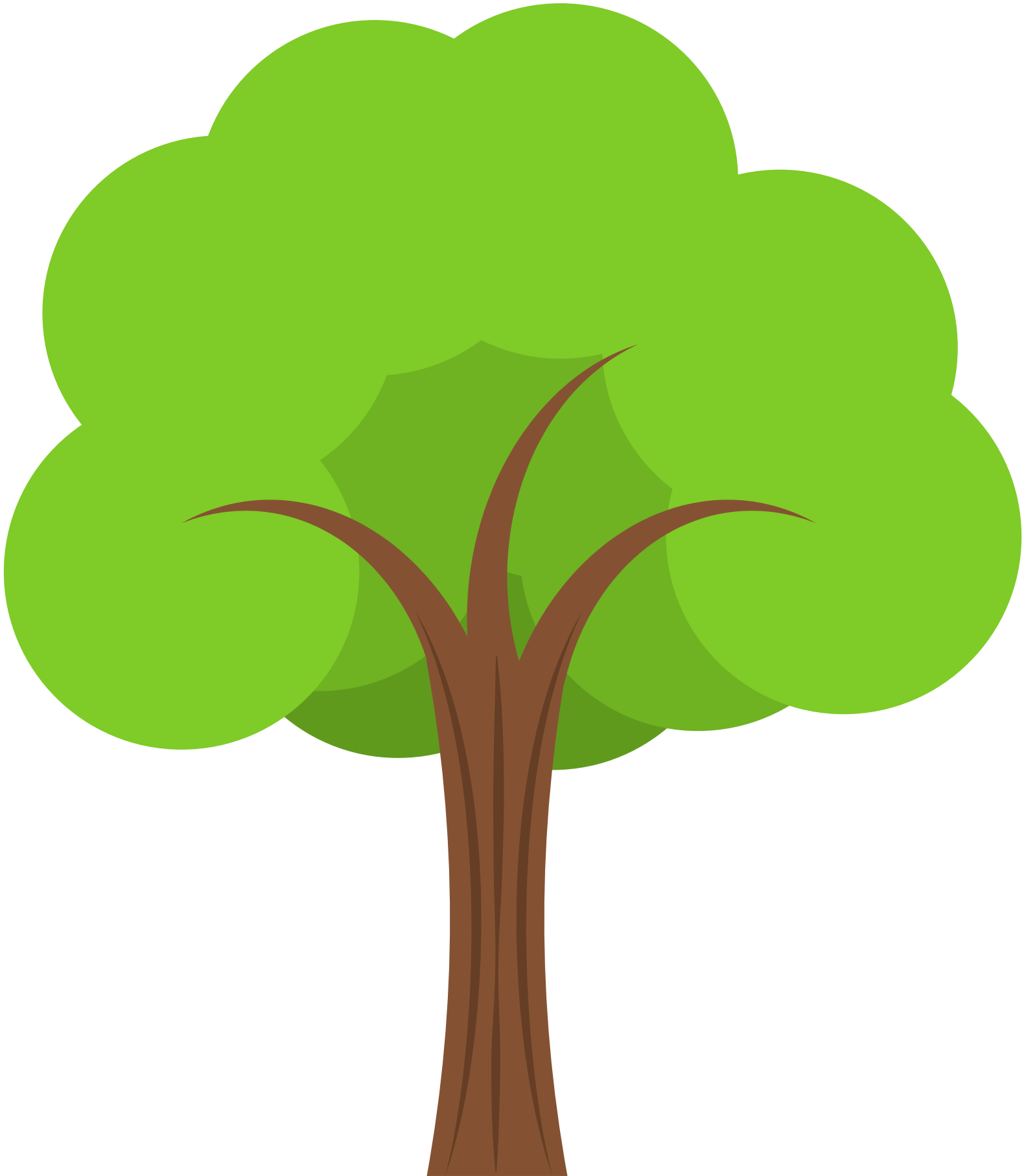
If you are doing this as a small group activity, you may want to give each child 2-3 leaves.

Pass out leaves and markers and have students write on each leaf, one thing that they are grateful for.

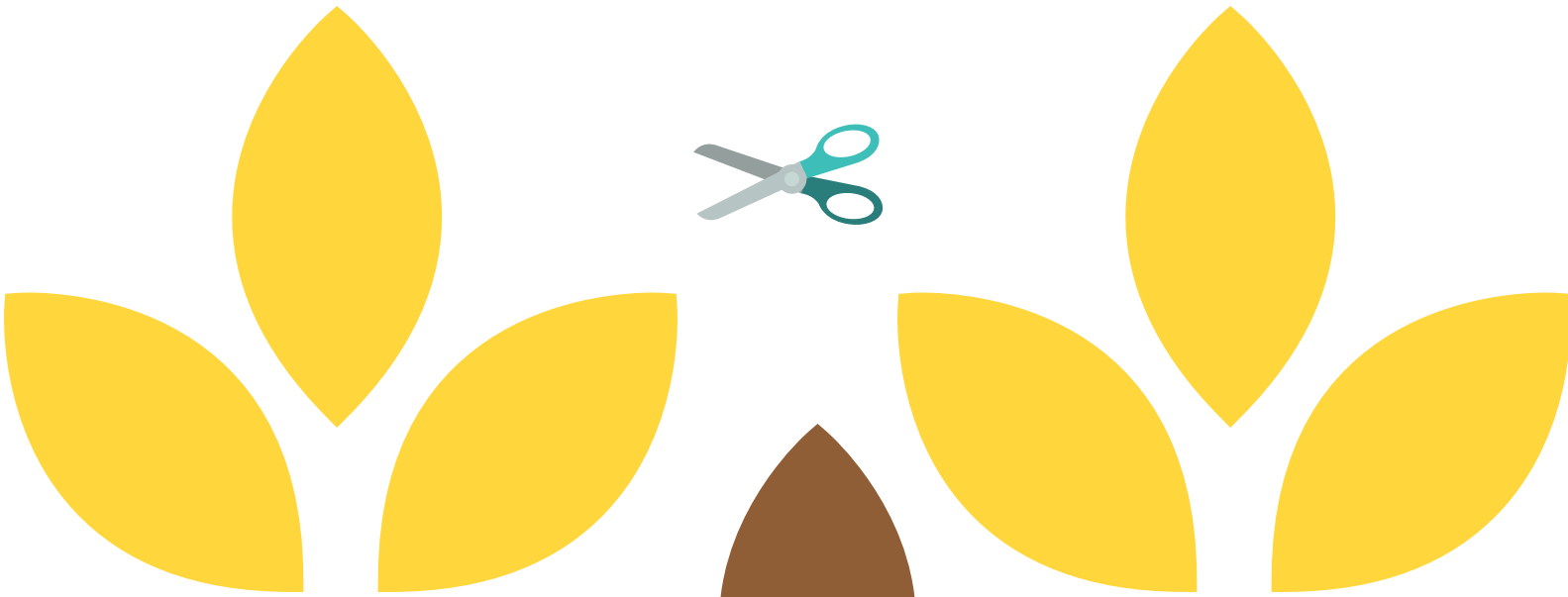
Next, students will glue their leaves onto the tree. When done, share with the group and discuss.

Leaves : Cut Out and Glue On Trees



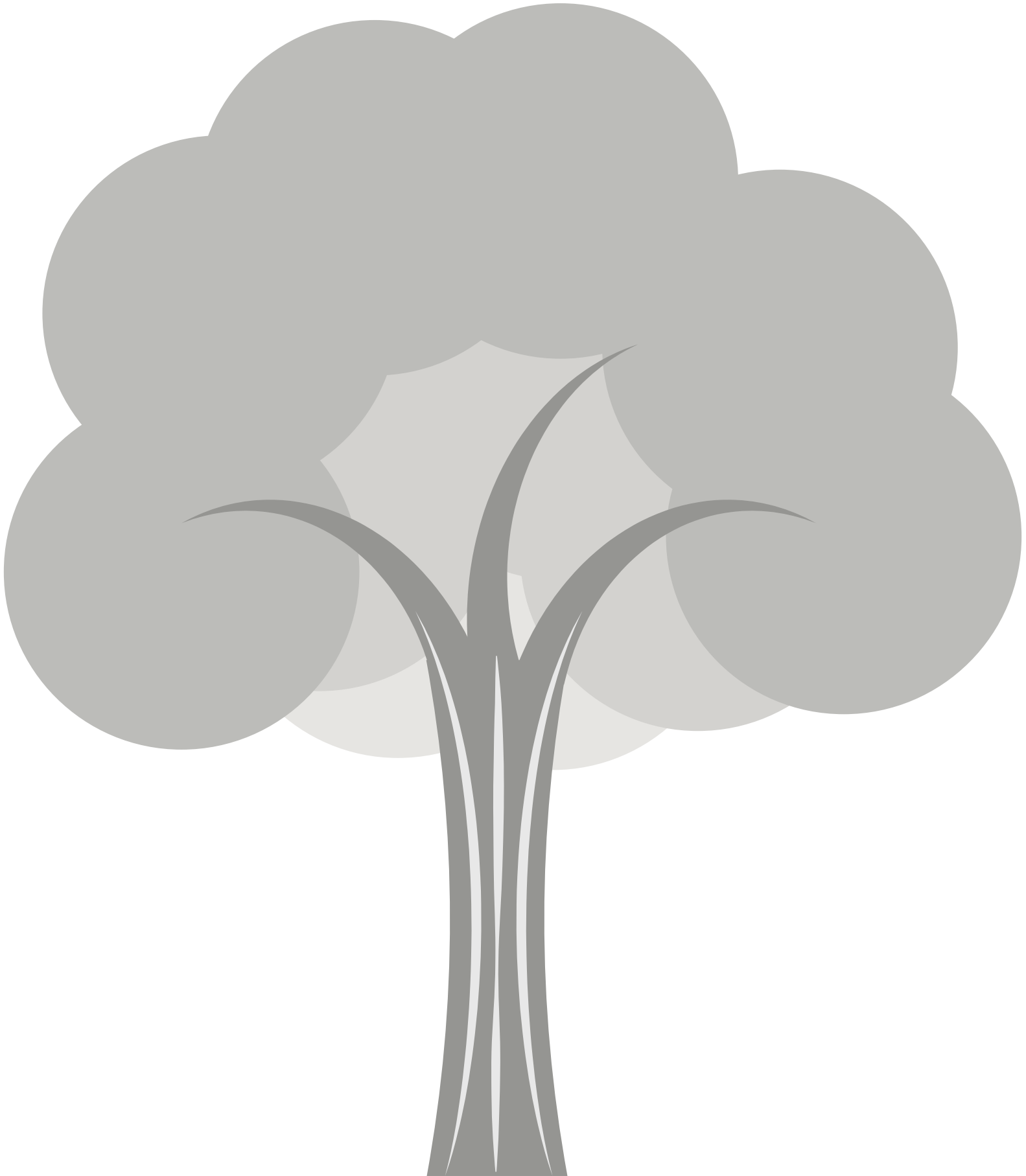
